

The James and Pauline Hackbarth Scholarship Program

An essential element of the Foundation's mission is to assist high school graduating Maywood residents with the financial burden of a college education.

Working through the Maywood Rotary, the Foundation has awarded over \$255,000 in scholarships since the program's inception in 2007.

Any graduating Maywood resident is eligible, and encouraged, to apply for one of these annual awards. In order to consider as many students as possible the criteria is weighted between academic achievement, community service and extracurricular activities, and leadership qualities. The intent is to identify the most well rounded Maywood students.

The scholarship application is available via the Maywood Library website, the Maywood library and your school's guidance counselor's office. Please complete the application as directed and mail to the address listed on the last page.

For students to better understand the evaluation criteria, the application will be judged as follows:

- 20% education performance
- 30% community service and extracurricular activities
- 30% leadership qualities
- 20% essay

The Foundation looks forward to celebrating Maywood's best and brightest by offering three, ten thousand dollar scholarships for the graduating class of 2017.
