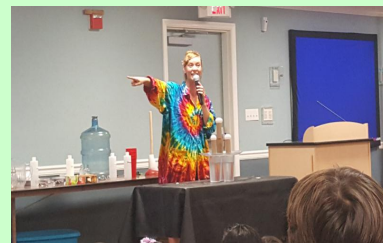

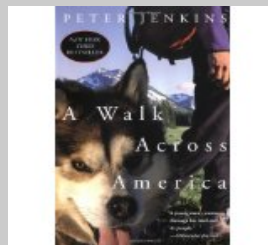

Adult Book Club



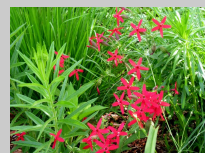

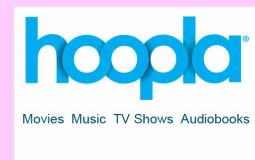
