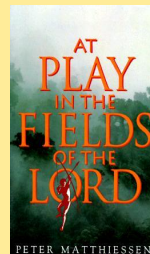
Free workshop with

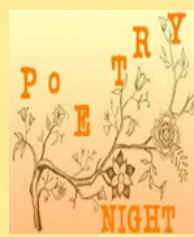
