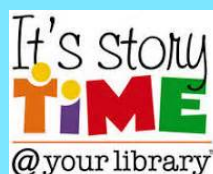

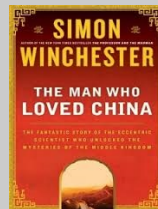

The Maywood Library Book Club will be discussing *The Man Who Loved China* by Simon Winchester at their next meeting on Friday, September 11th at 11 am in the library.

Winchester tells the story with colorful enthusiasm and Needham is a compendious subject, sympathetically treated with the help of the scholar's copious notes, letters and diaries.
