Come in a bathing suit or clothes you don't mind getting wet, bring a towel and prepare to get soaked playing water games as we celebrate the end of our

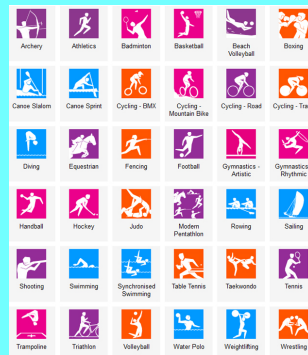

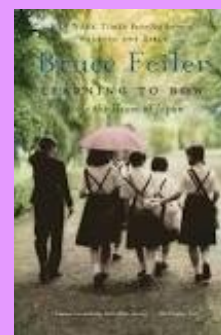
