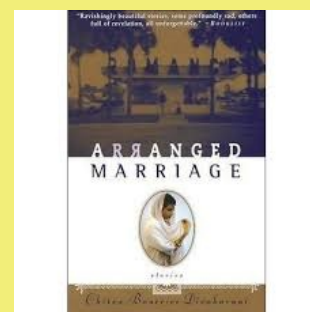

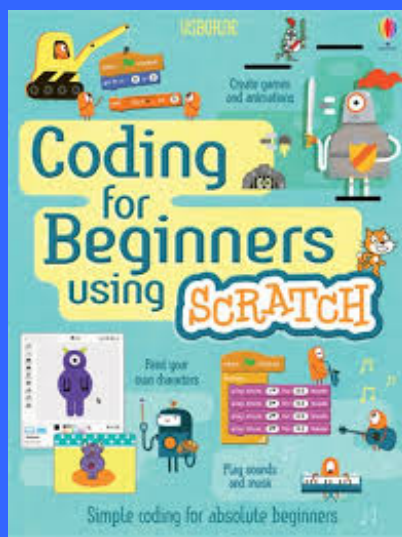
Effective June 1, the Library will be observing summer hours.

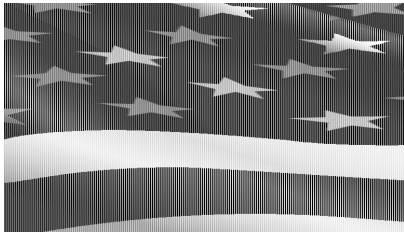


Stop in for some relaxing yoga stretches and a story or two! No registration required!
